Certified Local Government (CLG) Grant Application

- City of Arlington is designated as a Certified Local Government by the Texas Historical Commission
- Prior Year CLG Grants were used for Commission and Staff Training and Preservation Plan Development
- Landmark Preservation Commission (LPC) recommends using 2010 CLG funds for a consultant to serve as liaison to LPC for projects such as:
 - Implementation of Preservation Plan Goals
 - Local Marker Program
 - Bird's Fort Archaeological Survey
- Grant request due June 5 to Texas Historical Commission

Proposed CLG Grant Budget

Activity	CLG Budget	Match (CDBG/LPC)	Total
Preservation Consultant	\$20,000	\$21,200	\$41,200
Bird's Fort Survey	\$10,000	\$10,000	\$20,000
TOTALS	\$30,000	\$31,200	\$61,200

Community Development Block Grant – Recovery (CDBG-R)

- Source – American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009
- Amount -- \$853,342
- Requirements: Emphasis on job creation/retention through infrastructure improvement, housing, energy-efficiency and/or economic development activities
- Projects that can start within 120 days of grant agreement from HUD
- Substantial Amendment to PY08 Action Plan due June 5

Clearance and Demolition	\$100,000
Administration (5%)	\$42,667
