No handdelivered entries accepted after 5 p.m. Friday, March 1, 2024.
- Essays will be judged on the elements of effective writing: Focus and Coherence, Organization, Development of Ideas, Voice and Conventions. The decision of the Judges is final.
- Teachers may mail or hand-deliver all entries from their class, grade or school. - Students must reside within the City of Arlington.
