

Resolution No. 23- 246

A resolution authorizing the adjustment of fees for residential and commercial garbage and trash collection, and residential recycling collection services effective October 1, 2023

- WHEREAS, on February 22, 2005, by Resolution No. 05-095, the City Council authorized the execution of a Lease Agreement by and between the City and Republic Waste Services of Texas, Ltd. (Republic) for the lease of the City's sanitary landfill; and
- WHEREAS, on September 29, 2020, by Resolution No. 20-258, the City Council authorized the execution of an amended and restated Agreement for the Arlington Landfill Lease with Republic; and
- WHEREAS, such Agreement provides for the application of an annual adjustment factor to the monthly fees and payments made by Republic to the City; and
- WHEREAS, one of these monthly payments, the City Collector Disposal Return, formerly known as the City Collector Disposal Royalty Fee, is defined in the Lease Agreement as the net difference between the City Collector Disposal Fee and the City Waste Disposal Fee; and
- WHEREAS, the City Waste Disposal Fee is subject to the annual adjustment factor specified in the Lease Agreement, while the City Collector Disposal Fee is established in the Lease Agreement and may be adjusted only by action of the City Council; and
- WHEREAS, the City Collector Disposal Fee was last adjusted by the City Council on September 14, 2021, by Resolution No. 21-227; and
- WHEREAS, the landfill gate rate charged for Self-Haul Residential Waste was last adjusted by the City Council on September 13, 2022 by Resolution No. 22-259; and
- WHEREAS, the residential and commercial garbage and trash collection, and residential recycling collection fees were last adjusted by the City Council on September 13, 2022 by Resolution No. 22-258; and
- WHEREAS, on August 2, 2022, by Resolution No. 22-196, the City Council authorized the execution of a contract with Republic Waste Services of Texas, Ltd. Relative to residential and commercial collection and disposal of garbage, trash, brush, other refuse and recycling services; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Republic's contract, Republic is seeking a rate increase that reflects increases in operational costs, including labor and maintenance of vehicles, and processing of recyclables; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ARLINGTON, TEXAS:

I.

That the City Collector Disposal Fee, as defined in Section 8.03 of the Lease Agreement between the City and Republic, is hereby adjusted to \$33.56 per ton, effective October 1, 2023.

II.

That effective October 1, 2023, Resolution No. 22-258 is hereby superseded in its entirety.

III.

That effective October 1, 2023, the monthly fee for residential collection and removal of garbage and trash, once-a-week recycling service, up to two cubic yards of bulky household waste each week, and up to two cubic yards of brush and/or yard waste each week, shall be \$19.19 plus applicable sales taxes. Such amount shall include applicable franchise fees and billing costs.

IV.

That effective October 1, 2023 thru March 1, 2024, the monthly fee for commercial bagged trash service shall be \$28.99 plus applicable sales taxes, and \$10.95 for each additional cubic yard, plus applicable sales taxes. Effective March 1, 2024, the monthly fee for commercial 95-gallon trash cart service shall be \$28.99 plus applicable sales taxes, and \$19.62 for each additional 95-gallon trash cart, plus applicable sales taxes. Such amounts shall include applicable franchise fees and billing costs.

V.

That effective October 1, 2023, the fees for additional recycling services available during the once-weekly pick-up at the request of residential and commercial customers shall be: \$3.05 plus applicable sales taxes for each additional residential recycling cart, and \$9.08 plus applicable sales taxes for each additional commercial recycling cart. Such amounts shall include applicable franchise fees and billing costs.

VI.

That effective October 1, 2023, the charges for the collection and removal of excessive brush, bulky waste or yard waste will be as follows:
