



DAnnual Requirements Contract for Automatic Gate Repair and Maintenance Services, Project 22-0036

City Council Meeting Date: 03-08-2022 Action Being Considered: Minute Order

RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute an annual requirements contract for automatic gate repair and maintenance with Artex Overhead Door Company, of Grand Prairie, Texas, in the estimated amount of \$30,000; and D.H Pace Company, Inc., of Coppell, Texas, in the estimated amount of \$30,000; for a total contract amount of \$60,000. Artex Overhead Door Company and D.H Pace Company, Inc. are not MWBE firms.

PRIOR BOARD OR COUNCIL ACTION

None.

ANALYSIS

A Request for Proposal (RFP) was issued to solicit responses from various firms with experience in providing preventative maintenance, repair and replacement of automatic gates at various locations in the City. The work will consist primarily of annual and quarterly preventative maintenance, as well as as-needed repairs and replacement of gates that become inoperable.

The following vendors submitted proposals and were reviewed based on criteria relative to operational planning, cost of service, and company experience.

Both vendors presented strong proposals. Therefore, it was determined to be in the best interest of the department to award the contract to both vendors, dividing service area into North and South locations.

- Artex Overhead Door Company, of Grand Prairie, Texas, will be awarded primary vendor for the preventative maintenance, repair, and replacements of gates in the northern section of the city: and alternate for the preventative maintenance, repair, and replacements of gates in the southern section of the city.
- D.H Pace Company, Inc., of Coppell, Texas, will be awarded primary vendor for the preventative maintenance, repair, and replacements of gates in the southern section of the city: and alternate for the preventative maintenance, repair, and replacements of gates in the northern section of the city.

Awarding to multiple vendors will allow for dedicated work at a location by a single vendor – ensuring consistent quality for services performed. Additionally, it will allow work to be done at multiple locations simultaneously if needed. Finally, selected vendors were awarded a primary locations and alternates to ensures that work will continue in the event the primary vendor cannot fulfill their contractual obligations.
