Annual Requirements Contract for High Density Polyethylene Water Pipe, Bid Project 24-0001

RECOMMENDATION

Authorize the City Manager or his designee to approve an annual requirements contract for the supply and delivery of High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) Pipes with Consolidated Pipe & Supply Co., of Fort Worth, Texas, in the estimated amount of \$508,250. Consolidated Pipe & Supply Co. is not a MWBE firm.

PRIOR BOARD OR COUNCIL ACTION

None.

ANALYSIS

This contract is for the supply and delivery of HDPE water pipes. The HDPE water pipe will be utilized to replace 6-inch, 8-inch, and 12-inch high break frequency water mains. Although the bid specifications were calculated per square footage and unit price, the Arlington Water Utilities department anticipates replacing 150,000 linear feet of water mains over the next 5 years by an in-house construction crew. HDPE pipes will be ordered on an as-needed basis.

supporting documentation, which is in accordance with the City's MWBE policy. Consolidated Pipe & Supply Co., will be self-performing the scope of the services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Consolidated Pipe & Supply Co., of Fort Worth, Texas, returned the lowest responsive bid for an estimated amount of \$508,250. The Water Utilities Department and the Office of Procurement agree the vendor meets the bid specification requirements. The projected financial impact for this contract term is as follows:
